DANIEL GASSER



Official Single Judge

Daniel Gasser, who is in his early forties, is from Velturno, Bolzano.

The family farm is located in Velturno in the wonderful green countryside, with the spectacular backdrop of the Dolomites. Together with his wife, Daniel manages his herd that consists of 70 Brown Swiss animals, including 35 cows.

The average milk production is about 10,000 kg milk with 4.2% fat and 3.8% protein.

Gasser has been a breeder representative in numerous province and state organizations. He was also the President of the Superbrown Consortium of Trento and Bolzano.

Gasser has been a Brown Swiss Classifier since the early 2000s and has classified over 10,000 cows in a lot of show abroad including the National Shows in Austria, Germany and Switzerland. He has also judged Holstein, Red Holstein, Jersey, Pinzgau and Gray Swiss breed.

GENTILE VITO



Deputy Show Judge

Mr. Vito Gentile is from Puglia and was born and raised on the family farm. For almost twenty years he has been a classifier and show judge, with the qualification of Breed Inspector. In recent years he has also been operating as a "multi-breed classifier", significantly increasing the number of animals classified each year.

His farm in the heart of the Murgia countryside of Taranto has a herd of 50 animals, including 30 cows. The average yearly production of his cows is around 95 kg of milk with 3.91% fat and 3.80% protein. He also bred important AI sires: the best known are Potassium, Bloxoy, Phenomenon, Ionian.

He began classifying Bruna animals in 2002; he has classified over 50,000 cows and has judged in over 100 shows, including six national shows.

Mr. Gentile represents breeders in various provincial and national organizations. Currently, he is one of the members of the board of ARA Puglia.
